Glossary

Baluster - small post or column that supports the railing of a staircase

Conical tower- a tower in the shape of a cone

Decorated porches- porches that are adorned with something ornamental

Dentils- repeating rectangular blocks that resemble teeth

Dormer- a small window projecting from the slope of a roof

Finial - an ornament at the top of a spire or steeple

Gingerbread - elaborate ornamentation

Jigsaw ornament - a decorative addition edged as a saw

Newel post - a post that supports the handrail at the bottom or top of a staircase

Shingle - a thin, oblong piece of material that is laid in overlapping rows on the roof or sides of a house
